30 Seconds and Under Short Video Challenge: In honor of our 30th Shortsfest, Aspen Film will be running a month-long video competition to find an original short video that's 30 seconds or less. Following in the footsteps of our core values: to enlighten, enrich, educate, and entertain through film, we hope to put a spotlight on emerging short video creators and the beauty of amateurism.

Dates: Submissions for the general public will open March 3rd and close April 3rd. Submissions should be emailed to thowe@aspenfilm.org

Judging: The top 10 will be posted to Aspen Film's IG (on April 4th) and the winner will be chosen by AF's social media community and the Youth Jury on April 5th. Winning video will be displayed on Aspen Film's website + shown at the Awards Event.

Video requirements: The only submission requirement is that the video has to be 30 seconds and under. Tik Tok's and IG Reels are welcome!
